



Clearance to Return after Exclusion for Symptoms

At Salisbury Academy, all family and faculty/staff households are screened daily for the presence of COVID-like symptoms, including fever, sore throat, difficulty breathing, cough, muscle aches, and new loss of taste or smell.

The presence of these symptoms is presumed to indicate the presence of COVID-19. The symptomatic household must remain out of the center for an exclusion period of at least ten (10) days, unless the household provides clearance to return from a medical provider.
