
Middle School Uniform Policy, Grades 5-8

PE Uniforms: *Students will dress out for PE according to their class schedule.

Uniform Policy Notes

*Students should adhere to the following notes on uniform and non-uniform days.

The Salisbury Academy Uniform Policy encourages students to have a positive self-image and to show school spirit. Students should arrive to school each day ready to learn, looking respectful, neat, and professional. Please adhere to the following when dressing for school in order to promote our community standards:

• Leggings are permitted if the garment worn over the leggings is fingertip length.

- Undergarments may not be visible- take care that clothing is not too loose or too tight in order to avoid this issue.
- Outerwear (hoodies, sweatshirts) should not be longer in length than bottoms. Shorts, skirts, and dresses must be no shorter than mid-thigh in length.
- Students may not wear articles of clothing which refer to social or political images or messages
 likely to cause a substantial disruption or that refer to other matters such as alcoholic
 beverages, tobacco, illegal substances or activities, weapons, or other similar potentially
 disruptive images or messages that could be reasonably perceived as vulgar, offensive, lewd,
 or indecent or reasonably likely to materially interfere with school activities.
