Duties/Responsibilities:

- Plan, prepare, and deliver instructional activities that facilitate relevant and experiential active learning

- Maintain and develop lesson plans that address the content and, wherever possible, align with the annual theme and portrait of a graduate skills
- Collaborate with peer teachers to create a coherent, connected curriculum enhanced by real-world application
- Identify and select differentiated instructional resources and implement methods to meet students' varying needs
- Instruct and monitor students in the use of learning materials and equipment to build their independence as learners
- Use relevant technology to support instruction

- Design and provide feedback on class work, homework, tests, and other assignments in a way that fosters higher-level, critical, and creative skill development
- Maintain accurate and complete weekly records of students' overall progress and development and as required by law and by school
- Collaborate with each student's team of supporters (parents/guardians, teachers, support services, etc) to enhance student academic and skill development
- Prepare required reports on students and activities
- Manage student behavior through established classroom procedures
